





Homage to J. Francisco Morales Domínguez

To the teacher, companion and friend

On October 2, we held an event in tribute to Professor J. Francisco Morales Domínguez who, since last September, has opted for his retirement and began his new relationship with the university as Professor Emeritus in the Department of Social and Organizational Psychology of the UNED.

The auditorium of the Faculty of Psychology of the UNED welcomed numerous colleagues from the different universities of Spain. Among the attendees, we could also see professors and professors from other branches of science, members of the Academy of Psychology of Spain, of the Royal Academy of Doctors, all of them, eager to convey their recognition and appreciation to Paco.

The academic ceremony began with a table in which six esteemed colleagues presented arguments that justified the recognition of Francisco Morales' career as a career of excellence.



Presiding over the table, Ms. Ana María Pérez, dean of the Faculty of Psychology of the UNED, and as speakers, five extraordinary witnesses and companions of the career of J. Francisco Morales: professors Helio Carpintero, Amalio Blanco, José Manuel Sabucedo, Carmen Huici and Fernando Molero. The director of the Department of Social Psychology and Organizations of the UNED, Iciar Fernández Sedano, as hostess, welcomed the attendees and the dean who inaugurated the event.

The event concluded with a few words from the dean and with the projection of a video that showed some of the significant moments of the career of J. Francisco Morales.

At the end of the event, an aperitif allowed us to enjoy lively conversations between the attendees and the signs of recognition and affection for Paco, Samples that flooded the place with shared affection.

The event was a portrait of the excellence of Paco's career, but also a portrait of the attendees, who in person and virtually, recognized the values and qualities that have made Paco's career a career of excellence.

Mr. Helio Carpintero. President of the Royal Academy of Psychology of Spain, he spoke as a teacher, as a friend and as a careful reader, in this case, of Paco's works.

Helio Carpintero drew a portrait of the social psychologist in Paco and his conception of social psychology as a science in society. To do this, he cited verbatim texts written by Paco throughout his career. Quotes from his writings from the 70s, 80s, 90s and the most recent writings of recent years.

In a neat way, he manages to highlight a constant in his writings: his reflections constitute authentic epistemological contributions to psychology.

From his first writings in the 70s, 80s and 90s that contributed to the construction of the then nascent academic psychology. To the most recent writings of the twenty-first century, in which the crystallization of a social psychology as a science that contributes to individual and collective well-being is detected. A social psychology that is already recognized as having its own space and different from that of general psychology.



Amalio Blanco, Professor at the Autonomous University of Madrid. In his speech, he transported us to a stage where he made us observers of a relaxed conversation between the two colleagues, the two teachers, the two friends.

In his speech, he vindicated a social thought built on the frame of reference provided by those people who have already traveled a certain distance.

In his conversation, he highlighted the importance that some of the milestones in social psychology to which Paco has contributed and some of the reflections that still inspire him continue to have in his daily work. The readings of the year 89, in honor of Tajfel; which he recovered with Carmen Huici. The refusal to carry out research in a social vacuum. The creation, together with José Miguel Fernández-Dols and himself, of the Journal of Social Psychology, as a space for the recovery of European social psychology. The Report of the Chair of Francisco Morales at the UNED. Finally, and continuing this relaxed conversation with Paco, he proposed a new meeting, one in which they would discuss the radical Kantian evil in the light of reading "The Adversary" by Emmanuel Carrere. It turned out to be an erudite and at the same time endearing conversation.

José Manuel Sabucedo, Professor at the University of Santiago de Compostela, delighted us with a portrait of Professor Morales traveling through the origin of Spanish social psychology. In doing so, it allowed us to see a generation of professors who were creating the first milestones of the discipline in Spain: the First Meeting on "Situation and Perspectives of Social Psychology in Spain", held in Barcelona, in 1980; the First National Congress of the area, held in Granada, in 1985 and others.

En definitiva, un miembro ejemplar de los pioneros de la psicología social en España.

Carmen Huici, catedrática da la Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia, nos ofreció una visión privilegiada de Paco Morales, como compañera con quien Paco ha compartido departamento gran parte de sus años en la universidad, destacó de forma escueta pero con determinación tres de las grandes cualidades de nuestro compañero.

En su investigación, la amplitud, la diversidad y la relevancia social de sus aportaciones. En la docencia, su productividad científica, y su impacto como mentor de doctorandos que ocupan hoy puestos de relevancia.

En cuanto a su contribución a la visibilidad de la psicología social. Destacó las múltiples vías y foros en los que difundió su conocimiento.

Trasversalmente al ámbito investigador y docente, destacó dos grandes cualidades: su iniciativa para colaborar y facilitar la cooperación y la construcción critica del conocimiento que le ha llevado a dar un enfoque más preciso a los temas que ha estudiado y que han determinado líneas de estudio más certeros.

Sus aportaciones al estudio de la identidad social y del liderazgo son ejemplo de cada una de estas aportaciones y cualidades.

En su exposición supo transmitir su profundo reconocimiento y aprecio al trabajo y a la persona que es Paco Morales.

Fernando Molero, Catedrático da la Universidad Nacional de Educación a Distancia y actual Vicedecano de Investigación de la facultad de psicología de la UNED, retrató magistralmente el impacto del profesor Morales como un maestro que lleva a sus doctorandos a alcanzar sus objetivos científicos y académicos. Hizo disfrutar a la audiencia con anécdotas cotidianas en sus intercambios con Paco. Rememorar estos recuerdos que contagiaron a la audiencia del clima de trabajo con Paco, no impidieron al profesor Molero destacar al Paco maestro, poseedor de un profundo conocimiento, de una generosidad y exigencia que le han permitido llevar a buen puerto los proyectos de sus doctorandos y colaboradores.
